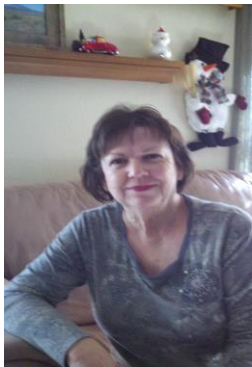

Barbara Krieger, Activities



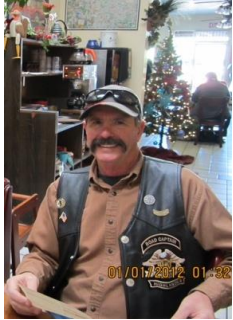
