## Kim Weber Safety SAFETY TIP

Proper Riding Gear

At the September meeting our safety talk was about the importance of proper riding gear. You should have sturdy BOOTS that cover your ankles instead of flip-flops or sneakers. Temperature permitting, CHAPS are best for your legs, but wear jeans at a minimum, no shorts. Again, temperature permitting, wear your leather JACKET. And the HELMET is a no-brainer (no pun intended).

I always recommend a full-face helmet. The more of your face that's exposed with a half helmet or a beanie, the greater your chance of severe injury if your face hits the pavement.

Remember Murphy's Law. The toast always falls butter side down. The same thing applies to a motorcycle crash. I know it's tempting to be stylish

out on that big shiny machine. But it's better to be safe instead of flashy.

SAFETY TIPS

Don't dress for the ride. Dress for the crash.













## Aug. 13, 2023 ~ Garys ride to Downieville
