



Hello Harley Riders !!

Well, summer is here and the heat is definitely upon us.

This is the time of year that we enjoy riding with minimal gear(even though that's not recommended) and we go on some beautiful rides in the back roads of our neighborhoods.

Even though sunscreen is not the best thing for us to use some of us need to use it because it does help. One thing that we all have to worry about is getting sunburn on our arms which are extended and exposed through the entire ride and our faces and neck.

Also, that helps is those cooling scarves that you can put around your neck that once you wet them, they stay cool and help regulate your temperature and another thing that helps is those protected sleeves that we slide on to protect our arms. I use them when I go fishing and they have a rating of between 35 and 50. And they help quite a bit to keep my arms from frying.

Another thing we need to worry about is making sure we stay hydrated. And drinking water when we get thirsty and your mouth is dry is way too late. You're already dehydrated at that point. And if you get to that point plain water most of the time just takes way too long to be effective.

I use a product called liquid IV (and there are many other products that work the same way) It's just a small pouch of powder that you pour into a bottle of water and it has an electrolytes, vitamins and all kinds of stuff to help you hydrate much faster than just plain water. I keep a Ziploc bag with three or four of those in one of my saddle bags just in case it's needed.

I speak from experience getting dehydrated while you are riding and starting to cramp up it's something that I don't wanna experience again and I'm sure that none of you want to experience that scary feeling while you're on your motorcycle.

So let's enjoy summer, let's not get sunburned or become

dehydrated.


